



Covid 19

Celebrations such as Sinterklaas and Christmas take place without outsiders. At the moment we are looking, together with the party committee, at how we can celebrate Sinterklaas in a responsible way.

All school staff and children stay at home if they have complaints related to corona and may only return to school when a negative result (given by the GGD) has been confirmed.

A negative self-test is not sufficient. Children who fall under the snub nose policy are allowed to go to school as long as there is no other positive tested classmate or teacher in the classroom. In doubt as to whether your child may attend school? Consult the decision tree.

If a housemate, family member or other close contact is infected with the coronavirus, all housemates (including children) go into quarantine. Schools may take additional measures in consultation with the MR. When we take such measures, we will notify you.

We realise that keeping children at home can be difficult for parents/carers to combine with their own work. However, we would urge you to adhere to the measures relating to keeping children at home in the event of complaints or tests. Children do not always get sick from the coronavirus but they do pass it on, also to the teachers. When teachers drop out, even more children will stay at home. We therefore ask everyone to follow the advice given regarding testing and quarantine.

For now, the following measures apply on the Brink:

- Parents may only enter the school by appointment.
- The walk-in in the lower and middle sections is cancelled; unfortunately you may no longer bring your son/daughter to class in the morning.
- If you have an appointment at school, you need to wear a mouth mask and keep 1.5 meters distance from others.
- Do you have corona related complaints? Then stay home and make a new appointment.
- For the time being, parent meetings will take place digitally.


On Thursday 23rd December, we will have a Christmas brunch for the children from 11.00 to 13.00 hours. More information about this brunch will follow.
